Baltac Sewer Update

Construction Complete

The RDEK Baltac Sewer Project is now complete. A successful live test of the sewer system was done on November 26, 2010. There are a few minor things that will be completed in the spring: however, all major work is complete and the system is on line and ready for connections.

The total project budget was \$2.6 million and while the final numbers are still being tallied, the project will be under budget.

The RDEK Board of Directors committed \$500,000 in Community Works (Federal Gas Tax) funding, which will help offset costs for the community.

The RDEK would like to thank the community for its cooperation and patience during construction.

System Operations and Maintenance

Windermere Water and Sewer Company (WWSC) will handle all billing and will also collect the user fees on behalf of the RDEK. When you connect to the Sewer System, an account will be set up with WWSC.

Connection Required Within 3 Years

It is the homeowner's responsibility to connect their home to the curbstop within 3 years and arrange proper permits and inspections prior to connection.

There are two key steps prior to connection (detailed below):

- RDEK plumbing permit/inspection; and
- 2. Connection inspection.

For connection forms, account activation and to arrange the actual connection, homeowners should contact WWSC

Scheduling a Plumbing Inspection

Prior to connecting to the new system, you will need a plumbing permit, which is available through the RDEK's Columbia Valley Office.

The RDEK will conduct the plumbing inspection for the connection at the home and any E1 pumps or gravity connections in and around the home.

> This inspection must be done PRIOR to connecting to the sewer system.

Scheduling a Connection Inspection

WWSC must complete an inspection of the connection between the property line and the new sewer system.

To schedule the required connection inspection, receive the necessary forms, and activate an account, contact WWSC at 250-342-6999 PRIOR to connection.

Decommissioning Your Old System

The RDEK strongly recommends that old septic tanks be decommissioned. Please contact Interior Health at 250-420-2200 for information on how tanks can be properly and safely decommissioned.

We have had questions regarding whether they could be used as rain water collection barrels. This could cause slippages or terrain cracks and ground instability. Anyone considering this option should consult a Geotechnical Engineer prior to proceeding.
